RECITALS

A. Four Declarations of Protective Covenants and Restrictions ("Declarations") have been recorded in Washington County for five Sexton Mountain Meadows phases covering a total of 161 lots as follows:

- Sexton Mountain Meadows (Lots 1-41 = 41 homes), Declaration dated 1. November 7, 1988, and recorded in the records of Washington County, OR, on November 15, 1988, as Document No. 88-51074.
- Sexton Mountain Meadows No. 2 (Lots 42-79 homes = 38 homes), Declaration 2. dated August 14, 1990, and recorded in the records of Washington County, OR, on August 22, 1990, as Document No. 90-45427.
- Sexton Mountain Meadows No. 3 (Lots 80-101 = 22 homes), Declaration dated 3. December 10, 1991, and recorded in the records of Washington County, OR, on February 26, 1992, as Document No. 92-012039.
- Sexton Mountain Meadows No. 4, (lots 102-110 =- nine lots) and Sexton 4. Mountain Meadows No. 5 (lots 111-161 = 51 lots), Declaration dated March 21, 1995, and recorded in the records of Washington County, OR, on April 21, 1995. as Document No. 95-027619.

An instrument has been signed by 127 of the owners of the 161 lots subject to the Declarations which constitutes more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the Owners of the lots in each of the five Sexton Mountain Meadows phases listed in Paragraph A above. The original instrument is contained in the files of Sexton Mountain Meadows Planned Community Association, a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the state of Oregon (the "Association").

NOW THEREFORE

The undersigned, president and the secretary of the Association, hereby certify that more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the Owners of the lots subject to the Declarations listed in Paragraph A above have signed an instrument amending Article III, Section 6(A) to read as follows:

- A. Roof materials: The exterior surfaces of the roofs of all Houses shall be either:
 - i. cedar shake
 - ii. tile materials
 - iii. composition shingle simulating an architectural shake appearance. Any composition roof shall be of a style and color approved in writing by the Design Review Committee prior to installation, and shall have a minimum weight of not less than 425 lbs. per square. In no event shall a minimum 3-tab style composition shingle or basis metal roof be allowed on any House or structure.
 - iv. other approved product simulating a shake or tile appearance. Any product other than cedar shake or tile, or any product involving a change in color, shall be approved in writing by the Design Review Committee we prior to installation or the securing of any municipal permit.
